What is the purpose of this statement?

This statement provides key information about the ANZ Default KiwiSaver Scheme Conservative Fund. It tells you how the fund has performed and what fees it charged, and will help you to compare it with other funds. We prepared this statement in accordance with the KiwiSaver (Periodic Disclosure) Regulations 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of the fund

The Conservative Fund invests mainly in cash and fixed interest assets, with a smaller exposure to share and listed property assets. It may also invest in alternative assets. The objectives of the Conservative Fund are to:

- Consistently deliver positive real investment returns in the form of income and capital growth by investing in a range of asset classes; and
- Achieve investment performance that reflects the level of risk applicable to the Conservative Fund's underlying asset classes.

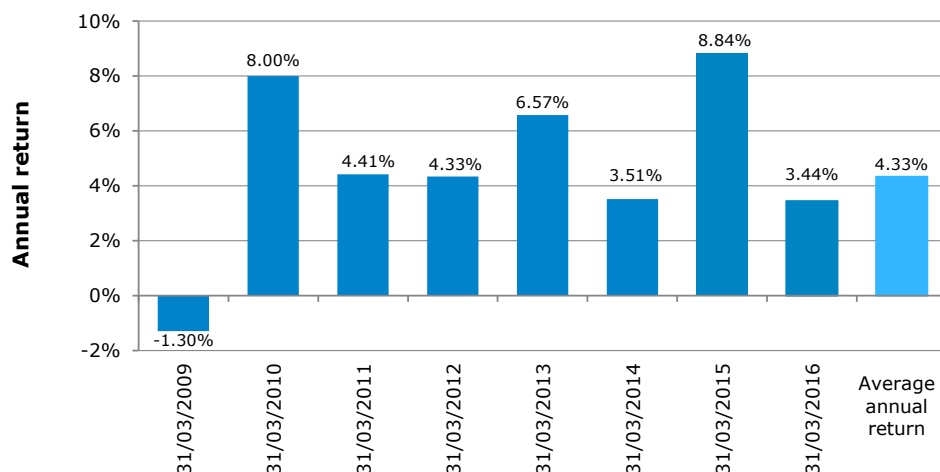

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How has the fund performed in the past?

What fees were members charged?

The returns above are after deductions for **fund fees**². These fees were last totalled up for the year to 31 March 2016 and were:

Members were also charged **membership fees**³ of up to \$24 over the year to 31 March 2016.

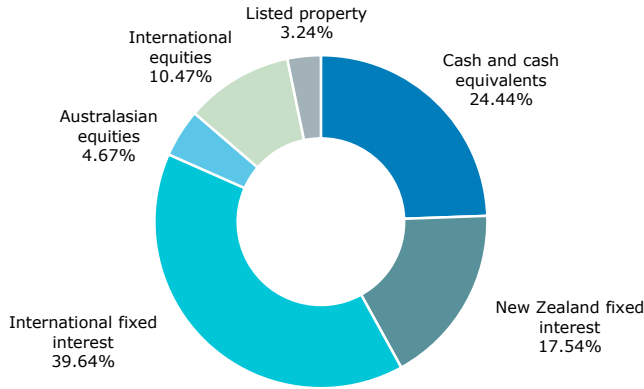
Example of how this applies to a member

Sarah had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and didn't make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Sarah received a return after fund fees and tax were deducted of \$383 (that's 3.83% of her initial \$10,000). Sarah also paid \$24 in membership fees³. This gives Sarah a total return of \$359 for the year.
