goMoney Wallet project wins international award

ANZ New Zealand and BellID have won *Best Mobile Banking Project* at the 2016 Asian Banker Technology Innovation awards, for their work on goMoney Wallet.

goMoney Wallet enables ANZ customers to use their compatible Android smartphone for contactless payments, just as they would a contactless card.

Liz Maguire, ANZ's Head of Digital and Transformation, said the judges found it remarkable that ANZ NZ had designed and developed most of goMoney Wallet.

"They were impressed with our level of ownership and involvement in the solution. ANZ goMoney Wallet is the first mobile payments solution integrated into a banking app. BellID provided the wallet software itself, and the rest was delivered in-house by our fantastic team," she said.

Craig Bunyan, General Manager Technology NZ said the solution showed ANZ had the expertise to create world-class solutions that were simple and intuitive for customers to use.

"It's rewarding to see Kiwi can-do creativity getting results and gaining recognition on the international stage," he said.

The key benefit of the goMoney Wallet is that it is within ANZ's trusted mobile banking app, ANZ goMoney, removing the need for a separate app or SIM card upgrade. Payments can be made with just one tap.

Using Host Card Emulation (HCE) technology, goMoney Wallet will feature the most advanced encryption technology to protect customers' financial information.

Having a mobile wallet offering for retail customers has also enabled ANZ to promote and increase the uptake of contactless terminals in New Zealand.
