What is the purpose of this statement?

This statement provides key information about the ANZ Default KiwiSaver Scheme Growth Fund. It tells you how the fund has performed and what fees it charged, and will help you to compare it with other funds. We prepared this statement in accordance with the KiwiSaver (Periodic Disclosure) Regulations 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of the fund

The Growth Fund invests mainly in share and listed property assets, with a smaller exposure to cash and fixed interest assets. It may also invest in alternative assets. The objectives of the Growth Fund are to:

- Consistently deliver positive real investment returns in the form of income and capital growth by investing in a range of asset classes; and
- Achieve investment performance that reflects the level of risk applicable to the Growth Fund's underlying asset classes.



How has the fund performed in the past?

What fees were members charged?

Members were also charged **membership fees**³ of up to \$26.25 over the year.


Example of how this applies to a member

Sarah had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and didn't make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Sarah received a return after fund fees and tax were deducted of \$1,697 (that's 16.97% of her initial \$10,000). Sarah also paid \$26.25 in membership fees³. This gives Sarah a total return of \$1670.75 for the year.
